Our Easter & October Junior Courses are aimed at students aged 11-18. They are serious language courses but with younger students in mind.

Most students on the course are aged 13-16 but we welcome students from the age of 11. Students can start and finish on any Saturday within the course dates.

Tuition

The course offers a balance of grammar, speaking, reading, writing and listening. On the Saturdays there are excursions to the Royal Armouries Museum in Leeds, The Manchester Museum of Science and Industry or Whitby. The afternoon programme gives students the opportunity to practise their English and see something of York! In 2010 we shall be spending afternoons at York Minster and The National Railway Museum. All the students will have a guided tour of the City including the famous medieval walls. Some afternoons will be spent in the city centre doing project work. During the course we run a variety of evening events including a visit to the cinema, ten-pin bowling and a farewell party. These events are all included in the tuition fees and the host families collect younger students from events which finish late. At the end of the course, students and their parents receive a full report and a certificate of attendance.

Accommodation and Welfare

We take extra care when selecting families and always try to help with special requests. We place great emphasis on welfare. All students have to follow the College curfew regulations and we are happy to set earlier times if parents wish. Students on our junior courses are automatically on full-board and all students receive a bus pass and insurance.

Accompanied Transfer Service

The courses start on a Saturday. Students are met at Manchester and Leeds Airports and escorted to York. The courses end on a Saturday. We take the students back to the airport, help them with check-in and make sure they go through security in time to catch their plane! For students who have difficulty arranging flights, we can make special arrangements to meet early or late flights or flights to other airports at an additional cost.
