Notes:

There is a £75 booking fee for all course bookings. However, students returning within the same year, and families taking courses together, pay only one Booking Fee!

1 Our Junior Courses are made up of Young Learners and Young Adults. Young Learners' Courses are for students aged 11~17. We accept students from the age of 8 if accompanied by an adult and providing they are a confident A2 level (CEFR). Students aged 18~19 can join our Young Adults' Course but must accept the restrictions and ethos of a junior programme.

2 The Gold Course is open to students from the age of 40. Tuition only covers 15 hours of morning, classroom tuition only. Activities cover all afternoon activities and the Saturday excursion

Notes:

3 Bus passes are provided for students living more than 2km from the College. Students under the age of 18 are expected to share bedrooms (with a student from a different language).

4 There is no shared room option for individual bookings.

5 Subject to availability, rooms can accommodate up to 2 adults and 2 children.

6. Third and fourth guests must be under the age of 18.

7 Availability is very limited so this will be treated as a request with the surcharge being applied only if available. The only way to guarantee a private bathroom is to stay in Melton Guest House. Hosts offering a private bathroom forgo the opportunity to host two students. This is reflected in the price.

8 Vegetarian and "No Pork" do not count as special diets so there is no charge.

Melton Guest House operates independently of the College and is offered on Commercial booking sites where the price may differ from the prices shown here. Any booking made through such sites will be subject to the terms of the site, not the terms of the College. We have a tiny number of hosts who offer private bathrooms. We would encourage those for whom a private bathroom is important to consider staying at Melton Guest House.

Notes:

9 All students under the age of 18 must buy transfers from the College unless travelling with an adult or being met by prior arrangement by an adult with the agreement of the student's parents.

10 All transfers are, or may be, shared. On arrival, students may have to wait up to 2.5 hours for a transfer to leave. This time is calculated from published landing time + 60 mins. On departure students may be delivered up to 2.5 hours before the start of check in (120 mins before published departure). There is a £75 surcharge for flights arriving or departing between 2200 and 0900. Private taxi transfers are available, prices on request.

Our standard changeover day is **Sunday** so all course dates are shown starting and finishing on a Sunday **Open groups** are welcome on all Courses. We offer free accommodation for 1 leader for every 15 students during the Summer and every 10 students at other times. Open groups cannot join the Young Adults' programme.

Closed groups are welcome at any time except the period covered by the Summer Course and Easter Course. There is restricted availability during the Autumn Course.
